Brian Mainwaring Trophy – Only Open to Committee/Sub-Committee Members (Free Entry)

Any Drawn Competition – Teams Will be Drawn Randomly by Competition Secretary

Men's Triples/Mixed Pairs/Mixed Triples – Pick your Own Team (AND NOT Acceptable for Entry). Please Enter the Names of Partners on Your Entry Form but DO NOT Pay their Entry Fee. Each Player in a Team Should Complete Their Form in This Way.

Open Aussie Mixed Pairs – can be any combination of either two men, two ladies or mixed where you will choose your own partner.

Competition Rules:

Entry Costs are £2.00 Per Person Per Competition

To Enter You Must be Available for Finals Weekend

The Challenger shall, at the Earliest Opportunity, Offer Their Opponent a MINIMUM of 3 Different Dates as follows: ,

- **The 3 offered dates must include at least one week day and a weekend date.**
- **The time for the commencement of these games shall be mutually agreed but no competitor shall be compelled to agree a starting time on weekdays earlier than 6.00 pm or later than 6.30 pm.**
- **No challenge dates should coincide with any external fixed date competitions or leagues.**
- **First Offered dates must be a minimum of 7 days prior to the published Challenge by Date.**
- **The Challenger shall make all necessary arrangements for the game, book a rink online and arrange a marker for singles competitions.**
- **The scorecard must be signed and placed in the box in the changing room, which the Competition Secretary will check and remove.**
- **The winners of any round should update the draw sheet, putting themselves through to the next round and check their next opponent.**

It is Usual for Challengers to Phone Their Opponent to Discuss Dates/Times to Reach an Amicable Arrangement

Challenge by & Play by Dates Should be Strictly Adhered to. Any Extension MUST be Agreed by the Competition Secretary, Ideally with a Date Already Agreed by Participating Players

ANY Problems/Issues Please Contact the Competition Secretary at the Earliest Opportunity to Enable a Timely Resolution. Complex Issues May be Discussed with the Management Committee to Ensure a Fair Outcome.
